§1 Opening of the meeting

The board welcomed everybody.

§2 Opportunity to learn from other IES PTA's

Mr Christian provided information to the board to be able to participate in an exchange with other PTAs, hosted by IES Hässelby on February 3rd.

§3 Inviting more parents to contribute as classparents

- Parent engagement is low and there is fairly little interest in becoming class parents.
- In January we will take the initiative in recruiting class parents again – the goal is to have one class parent per class attend a PTA evening in school 28th January at 17:00.
- At this meeting we will have a general presentation of the Parent Association and create break-out groups where all class parents will meet in their respective years.

§4 Fundraising for end of grade 9 activity

- By the 28th of January the parent association will have a schedule of fundraising activities decided for each year, beginning in grade 6.
- Grade 8 students and parents will host a spring dance on the 19th February.
- Each semester there will be a fixed set of activities per grade and semester, for example as follows:
 - *Grade 6 fall: Sell candles*
 - *Grade 6 spring: Host bake sales / sell with coffee bike*
 - *Grade 7 fall: Host online auction*
 - *Grade 7 spring: Collect trash (paid activity)*
 - *Grade 8 fall: Host the fall dance for grade 4 & 5*
 - *Grade 8 spring: (i) Host the spring dance for grade 4 & 5, host the open house in May which will take place on a Saturday.*
 - *Grade 9 fall: To be determined*
- By creating pre-planned activities which are well prepared we hope to attract more parents and to have more activities take place.
- The parent association will create six bank accounts with Swish for each grade, as follows:
 - Class of 26
 - Class of 27
 - Class of 28
 - Class of 29

- Class of 30
- Class of 31
- General account for IES
- Comment: No bank accounts can be created for each class. When one class graduates, the bank account will be reused for next year's grade 4.
- When activities are held in the school, the money raised will be distributed equally to all grades irrespective of which grade is contributing to the event. When activities are held outside the school (selling candles, socks, collecting trash, bake sales), the money raised will go to the grade doing the work.

§5 Other

- Ideas of trips end of year 9 - Ms Poletti recounted many successful and inexpensive grade 9 trips that have been arranged in the past. Skärgårdsstiftelsen, Canoeing Högbo Bruk – Ockelbo, etc.
- The association has begun building a webpage www.ies-nacka-parents.com. It still needs a lot of work 😊.
